A BILL

To amend the National Assembly Allowances Act

ENACTED by the Parliament of Mauritius, as follows –

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the National Assembly Allowances (Amendment) Act 2008.

2. Interpretation

In this Act –

“principal Act” means the National Assembly Allowances Act.

3. Schedule to principal Act repealed and replaced

The Schedule to the principal Act is repealed and replaced by the Schedule to this Act.

4. Commencement

This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 July 2008.
