ENACTED by the Parliament of Mauritius as follows -

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Bus Industry Employees Welfare Fund (Amendment) Act 2004.

2. Interpretation

In this Act -

"principal Act" means the Bus Industry Employees Welfare Fund Act 2002.

3. Section 5 of principal Act amended

Section 5 of the principal Act is amended in subsection (2), by deleting paragraph (f) and replacing it by the following paragraph -

(f) 4 representatives of employees, appointed by the Minister after consultation with such unions of the bus industry employees as he may deem fit; and
