

**THE BUS INDUSTRY EMPLOYEES WELFARE FUND**  
**(AMENDMENT) BILL**  
**(No. VII of 2004)**

**Explanatory Memorandum**

The main object of this Bill is to amend the Bus Industry Employees Welfare Fund Act 2002 in order –

- (a) to increase the number of representatives of employees on the Board from two to four, and
- (b) to provide for the representatives of employees to be appointed after consultation with unions of the bus industry employees instead of the Trade Union Trust Fund.

## **A BILL**

### **To amend the Bus Industry Employees Welfare Fund Act 2002**

ENACTED by the Parliament of Mauritius as follows –

#### **1. Short title**

This Act may be cited as the Bus Industry Employees Welfare Fund (Amendment) Act 2004.

#### **2. Interpretation**

In this Act -

“principal Act” means the Bus Industry Employees Welfare Fund Act 2002.

#### **3. Section 5 of principal Act amended**

Section 5 of the principal Act is amended in subsection (2), by deleting paragraph (f) and replacing it by the following paragraph -

- (f) 4 representatives of employees, appointed by the Minister after consultation with such unions of the bus industry employees as he may deem fit; and
