### ARRANGEMENT OF CLAUSES

#### Clause

- 1. Short title
- 2. Appropriation for the service of the Mauritius Government
- 3. Provision for Capital Development

## A BILL

To make provision for the service of the Mauritius Government and for Capital Development for the financial year 2007-2008

ENACTED by the Parliament of Mauritius, as follows -

#### 1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Appropriation (2007-2008) Act 2007.

### 2. Provision for the Service of the Mauritius Government

- (1) A sum not exceeding fifty-one billion four hundred and ninety-four million rupees shall be and is hereby charged upon the Consolidated Fund for the service of the Mauritius Government for the financial year 2007-2008.
- (2) The expenditure of the said sum shall be in conformity with the Schedule to this Act.

## 3. Provision for Capital Development

A sum not exceeding ten billion and fifty million rupees shall be and is hereby charged on the sums –

- (a) in the Capital Fund as at 1 July 2007; and
- (b) receivable into the Capital Fund at anytime thereafter,

to defray the cost of works and other charges of capital development.
