A BILL

To amend the Constitution

ENACTED by the Parliament of Mauritius, as follows –

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Constitution (Amendment) Act 2016.

2. Section 15 of Constitution amended

Section 15 of the Constitution is amended, in subsection (3) –

- (a) in paragraph (a), by inserting, after the words “public health”, the words “‘otherwise than pursuant to paragraph (ca)’”;
- (b) in paragraph (b), by inserting, after the words “public health”, the words “,otherwise than pursuant to paragraph (ca)’”;
- (c) by inserting, after paragraph (b), the following new paragraph –
 - (ca) for the imposition of restrictions on the movement within Mauritius or on the right of any person to leave Mauritius pursuant to an order of a Court or a Judge of the Supreme Court under such law, being a law relating to offences or acts of terrorism;
