The Constitution (Amendment) Bill
(No. XXIX of 2015)

Proposed amendments to be moved at Committee Stage

The Clerk of the National Assembly presents her compliments to Honourable Members and has the honour to inform them that the Right Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs, Minister for Rodrigues and National Development Unit has given notice of the following amendments which he proposes to move at the Committee Stage of the above Bill –

In clause 2, in the proposed paragraph (aa) –

- (a) by deleting the words “to the extent” and replacing them by the words “or any other provision of Chapter II of the Constitution, to the extent”;
- (b) by inserting, after the word “confiscation”, the words “, except so far as that provision or, as the case may be, the thing done under its authority is shown not to be reasonably justifiable in a democratic society”.
