I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence & Home Affairs, Minister of Civil Service & Administrative Reforms and Minister of Rodrigues & Outer Islands, at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 05 August 2008 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence & Home Affairs, Minister of Civil Service & Administrative Reforms and Minister of Rodrigues & Outer Islands -

Whether, in regard to possession, importation and trafficking of Subutex, he will state -

- (a) **why the Dangerous Drugs Act has not been amended to date to provide for tougher penalties;**
- (b) **whether he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Commissioner of Police, information as to if the Police has information -**
 - (i) **regarding an organized gang involving one Sada Curpen and his close relatives, Police Officers, a Money Changer and a Bookmaker; and**
 - (ii) **that, on 23 July 2008, a politician phoned the Anti Drug Smuggling Unit whilst a controlled delivery was being effected at Riche Terre?**
