I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of Finance & Economic Development at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 06 May 2008 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask the Honourable Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of Finance & Economic Development:-

Whether, in regard to the economy and the budget, he will state the latest estimates of the –

- (a) Gross Domestic Product growth for 2008 and 2009;**
- (b) Recurrent and Capital Expenditure for 2007-2008, indicating the –**
 - (i) Recurrent Expenditure on Public Debt, Health, Education and Rodrigues; and**
 - (ii) Capital Expenditure on the National Development Unit projects, National Land Drainage Programme, Secondary Schools, Cultural Centres and Tourist Villages; and**
- (c) Recurrent and Capital Revenue for 2007-2008, indicating Revenue from Value Added Tax, Customs Duty, Income Tax, National Residential Property Tax, Campement Site Leases, Bank of Mauritius Remittance, Foreign Grants and Disposal of Assets?**
