Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence & Home Affairs, Minister of Civil Service & Administrative Reforms and Minister of Rodrigues & Outer Islands –

Whether, in regard to subutex, he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Commissioner of Police, information as to if a certain politician had phoned –

- (a) **the Anti Drug and Smuggling Unit headquarters, in connection with the arrest of one D. B., on 27 February 2006, in possession of Rs 2.5 million worth of subutex at the Sir Seewoosagur Ramgoolam International Airport; and**
- (b) **the Line Barracks Police Station, on 25 December 2007 at about 3.00 a.m., in connection with the case of an assault with cutter on a Police Serjeant at Arsenal by an habitual criminal and subutex dealer, on the same day?**
