**A BILL**

**To amend the Hindi Pracharini Sabha Act**

ENACTED by the Parliament of Mauritius, as follows –

**1. Short title**

This Act may be cited as the Hindi Pracharini Sabha (Amendment) Act 2009.

## **2. Interpretation**

In this Act –

“principal Act” means the Hindi Pracharini Sabha Act.

## **3. Section 6 of principal Act amended**

Section 6 of the principal Act is amended –

(a) in subsection (2) –

(i) in paragraph (a), by deleting the words “each annual” and replacing them by the word “a”;

(ii) in paragraph (b), by deleting the words “one year” and replacing them by the words “a period of 3 years”;

(b) in subsection (3), by deleting the words “an annual” and replacing them by the word “a”.

## **4. Transitional provision**

The members of the Committee in office at the commencement of this Act shall continue to hold office for the remaining period for which they have been elected.

## **5. Commencement**

This Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by Proclamation.
