Private Notice Question

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 12 November 2013 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues –

Whether, in regard to the Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting to be held in Sri Lanka, from 15 to 17 November 2013, and the human rights issue thereat, he will state if –

- (a) **he has had discussions with Dr the Honourable Minister of Foreign Affairs, Regional Integration and International Trade following his participation in the recent annual Commonwealth Foreign Ministers' Meeting and his meeting with the Foreign Affairs Minister of Sri Lanka;**
- (b) **he will attend the said Meeting following the recent developments in regard thereto, in particular, the decision of the Prime Minister of the Republic of India not to attend thereto; and**
- (c) **the President of Sri Lanka will be invited to the Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting to be held in Mauritius in 2015?**
