I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Alan Ganoo, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 16 July 2013 at 11.30 a.m.**

*To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues –*

**Whether, in regard to the recent alleged cases of corruption against two officers of the Supreme Court, he will –**

- (a) for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Commissioner of Police, information as to –**
  - (i) when the cases were reported to the police and by whom;**
  - (ii) the number of arrests effected in connection therewith, as at to date, indicating the charges preferred, in each case;**
  - (iii) if the inquiry has revealed any alleged case of hacking and any connection with gambling activities and illegal betting; and**
- (b) state the measures Government proposes to take to reinstate public confidence in the judiciary?**
