Private Notice Question

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Rt. Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs, Minister for Rodrigues and National Development Unit at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 08 September 2015 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask the Rt. Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs, Minister for Rodrigues and National Development Unit –

Whether, in regard to the recent incidents which occurred at the Tookay Temple and elsewhere, he will –

- (a) for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Commissioner of Police, information as to –**
 - (i) the number of arrest effected in connection therewith, as at to date, indicating if the arrested suspects have criminal/legal antecedents;**
 - (ii) the localities where the incidents occurred, including the ones which occurred during the weeks preceding the Tookay incidents; and**
 - (iii) if cases of *incitation à la violence* through the internet have been established; and**
- (b) state if he has discussed same with the Commissioner of Police and if he is satisfied with the work of the Police in relation thereto, as at to-date?**
