I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Rt. Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs, Minister for Rodrigues and National Development Unit at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 17 November 2015 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask the Rt. Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs, Minister for Rodrigues and National Development Unit –

Whether, in regard to the Constitution (Amendment) Bill (No. XXIX of 2015) and the Good Governance and Integrity Reporting Bill (No. XXX of 2015), he will state if –

- (a) Government still proposes to amend the Constitution to introduce therein the concept of confiscation without a definition thereof and, if so, indicate whether amendments to the Constitution (Amendment) Bill (No. XXIX of 2015) will be proposed;**
- (b) he will circulate the amendments to the Good Governance and Integrity Reporting Bill (No. XXX of 2015) as being proposed by Government; and**
- (c) Government still intends to introduce a new Declaration of Assets Bill?**
