**Private Notice Question**

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Vice-Prime Minister, Minister of Energy and Public Utilities at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 22 September 2015 at 11.30 a.m.**

*To ask the Honourable Vice-Prime Minister, Minister of Energy and Public Utilities –*

**Whether, in regard to electricity, he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain information as to –**

- (a) regarding the emergency measures recommended by the World Bank to ensure the security of supply thereof, where matters stand as to the –**
  - (i) appeals of CT Power and of Burmeister & Wain Scandinavian Contractor AS and the purchase of engines of 60 MW for the St. Louis Power Station;**
  - (ii) optimisation of maintenance;**
  - (iii) emergency voltage reduction;**
  - (iv) 37-year old Pielstick engines;**
  - (v) purchase of two 36 MW gas turbines; and**
- (b) if the price thereof will be lowered, following the windfall gains made by the Central Electricity Board due to the fall in the price of coal and of oil?**
