PRIVATE NOTICE QUESTION

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Dr Arvin BOOLELL, GOSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications and Minister for Rodrigues, Outer Islands and Territorial Integrity, at the sitting to be held today **Tuesday 03 November 2020 at 11.30 a.m.** –

To ask the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications and Minister for Rodrigues, Outer Islands and Territorial Integrity –

Whether, in regard to the acquisition of immoveable properties at Angus Road, Vacoas, in May and June 2008, he will –

- (a) **for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Independent Commission Against Corruption, information as to whether the Commission is in presence of an alleged complaint of corruption in relation thereto and, if so, indicate –**
 - (i) **the nature thereof; and**
 - (ii) **whether an investigation has been initiated thereinto and, if so, when, indicating when same is expected to be completed; and**
- (b) **state when mutual legal assistance with the United Kingdom was sought in relation thereto, indicating where matters stand?**
