PRIVATE NOTICE QUESTION

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Dr Arvin BOOLELL, GOSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications and Minister for Rodrigues, Outer Islands and Territorial Integrity, at the sitting to be held today **Tuesday 05 May 2020 at 11.30 a.m.** –

To ask the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications and Minister for Rodrigues, Outer Islands and Territorial Integrity –

Whether, in regard to the proposed easing of confinement restrictions with effect from 15 May 2020, he will state if necessary measures are being taken to –

- (a) control the risks of a second wave of Covid-19 infections, including by strengthening our health care preparedness and capabilities;
- (b) extend additional and temporary financial supports to household most affected by the lockdown of economic activities throughout the easing up phase; and
- (c) ensure that all rules and guidelines are put in place in relation to the proposed phased resumption of economic activities after consultations with businesses, trade unions and the civil society?
