I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Dr Arvin BOOLELL, GOSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications and Minister for Rodrigues, Outer Islands and Territorial Integrity, at the sitting to be held today **Thursday 11 June 2020 at 11.30 a.m.** –

To ask the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications and Minister for Rodrigues, Outer Islands and Territorial Integrity

Whether, in regard to the alleged corrupt and fraudulent practices unfolded by the African Development Bank concerning the tender for the redevelopment of the St. Louis Power Station, he will state –

- (a) if he was informed that an inquiry had been initiated thereinto, indicating if his Office was solicited to provide any assistance in connection therewith; and**
- (b) if his Office has been communicated with the adverse integrity report, indicating if he has measured the expected impact thereof on the credibility of Mauritius *vis-à-vis* the international financial institutions and international community?**
