I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Dr Arvin BOOLELL, GOSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications and Minister for Rodrigues, Outer Islands and Territorial Integrity, at the sitting to be held today **Tuesday 24 November 2020 at 11.30 a.m.** –

To ask the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications and Minister for Rodrigues, Outer Islands and Territorial Integrity –

Whether, in regard to the Independent Commission against Corruption, he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain therefrom, information as to –

- (a) the number of reported cases of the offence of making or accepting any payment in excess of Rs 350 000 under the Financial Intelligence Anti-Money Laundering Act 2002, having been discontinued, indicating –
 - (i) when; and
 - (ii) if any person has been questioned under warning between 2011 and 2014 regarding the purchase of properties by his good self at Angus road; and
- (b) if the contract of the current Director General has expired?
