Whether, in regard to the squatters of Port Louis, Rivière Noire and Grand Port, he will state the –

- (a) number of families on each site who have
 - (i) been regularized *in situ*;
 - (ii) been allocated an alternative site, indicating the number thereof who have physically moved to the new site;
 - (iii) neither been regularized *in situ* nor been allocated an alternative site; and
- (b) amenities, including water, sewerage, electricity, roads and street lighting, which have been installed at each site?
