I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Rt. Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs, Minister for Rodrigues and National Development Unit at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 19 July 2016 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask the Rt. Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs, Minister for Rodrigues and National Development Unit –

Whether, in regard to electoral reforms in mainland Mauritius and in Rodrigues, he will state –

- (a) if the United Nations Human Rights Committee has been informed of the stand of Government in relation thereto; and**
- (b) when the Ministerial Committee chaired by the Honourable Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of Tourism and External Communications, is expected to publish the recommendations thereof on the –**
 - (i) introduction of a dose of proportional representation in the National Assembly; and**
 - (ii) proposed amendments to the electoral system in Rodrigues, indicating if the State Law Office has already prepared a draft Bill in relation thereto?**
