I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Rt. Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs, Minister for Rodrigues and National Development Unit at the sitting to be held today, **Thursday 11 August 2016 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask the Honourable Rt. Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs, Minister for Rodrigues and National Development Unit –

Whether, in regard to the sovereignty of Mauritius over the Chagos Archipelago, he will state –

- (a) if he will render public the letter dated 7 or 8 July 2016 he had received from the out-going Prime Minister of the United Kingdom, Mr David Cameron;**
- (b) where matters stand regarding the –**
 - (i) resolution Mauritius is proposing to present to the forthcoming United Nations General Assembly; and**
 - (ii) implementation of the Ruling delivered on 18 March 2015 by the United Nations Arbitral Tribunal under the United Nations Convention of the Law of the Sea (UNCLOS); and**
- (c) if he has received replies to the letters he wrote to the President of the United States of America, Mr Barack Obama, and to the Prime Minister of the United Kingdom, Mrs Theresa May?**
