Private Notice Question

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérénger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Minister of Finance and Economic Development at the sitting to be held today, **Thursday 01 September 2016 at 2.00 p.m.**

To ask the Honourable Minister of Finance and Economic Development –

Whether, in regard to the claims for damages/compensations lodged against the State of Mauritius which are presently outstanding, he will state where matters stand, including those from –

- (a) Hogan Lovells International, on behalf of investors from the United Kingdom in relation to the implementation of projects in 2014 at Le Morne and at Pointe Jérôme respectively;**
- (b) Betamax Limited;**
- (c) CT Power (Mauritius); and**
- (d) the former British American Insurance,**

indicating, in each case –

- (i) the quantum of the damages/compensations claimed;**
- (ii) the legal/arbitral institutions dealing therewith, indicating the dates on which same have been/will be considered and who has represented/will represent the State of Mauritius thereat; and**
- (iii) if provisions have been made for the payment of the claims for damages/compensations, if any?**
