I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Minister of Public Infrastructure and Land Transport, at the sitting to be held today, **Friday 20 February 2015 at 3.00 p.m.**

*To ask the Honourable Minister of Public Infrastructure and Land Transport –*

**Whether, in regard to the Terre Rouge-Verdun Link Road (M3), he will state –**

- (a) the total sum paid to date to Colas Mauritius/Colas Madagascar and consultant EGIS BCEOM International;**
- (b) if a tender for treatment of landslides was awarded in 2014;**
- (c) why the original alignment was modified;**
- (d) if a *prima facie* case of conspiracy has been established at the level of the Road Development Authority;**
- (e) the temporary and permanent solutions that are being implemented concerning the cracks and settlement problems; and**
- (f) the urgent measures being taken to ease traffic in and out of Port Louis North?**
