Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs, Minister for Rodrigues and National Development Unit at the sitting to be held today, **Thursday 05 March 2015 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask the Rt. Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs, Minister for Rodrigues and National Development Unit –

Whether, in regard to the discussions allegedly having taken place recently between, on the one hand, the Honourable Minister of Technology, Communication and Innovation, the Honourable Minister of Financial Services, Good Governance and Institutional Reforms and the Honourable the Attorney General and Mr D. G., and the representatives of Dufry Ltd., the overseas supplier of Mauritius Duty Free Paradise Ltd., on the other hand, he will state if he has confirmed with the said Ministers whether same have indeed taken place and, if so, indicate –

- (a) the content of the discussions;**
- (b) the involvement, if any, of Mr D. G. in the said discussions ; and**
- (c) if the two representatives of Dufry Ltd. have been prevented from leaving Mauritius?**
