Private Notice Question

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Minister of Education and Human Resources at the sitting to be held today, **Saturday 16 November 2013 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask Dr the Honourable Minister of Education and Human Resources –

Whether, in regard to Government's decision to abolish the Certificate of Primary Education Examinations soon, as announced in the 2014 Budget Speech, he will state –

- (a) the time frame within which the CPE Examinations will be abolished;**
- (b) if Form III Examinations will replace the CPE Examinations; and**
- (c) the reasons why Government has taken so long to realise that the CPE Examinations stifle the intelligence, talents and abilities of children and impose on them the trauma of being branded as failures at the CPE level?**
