I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Alan Ganoo, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 11 June 2013 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues –

Whether, in regard to air safety on Air Mauritius flights, he will –

- (a) for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Civil Aviation Department, for the past three years, information as to the number of reported –**
 - (i) safety incidents, indicating if any investigation has been carried out thereinto and, if so, the outcome thereof; and**
 - (ii) near miss cases, indicating if any investigation has been carried out thereinto and, if so, the outcome thereof; and**
- (b) state if the post of director of the Civil Aviation Department is vacant and, if so, when it will be filled?**
