Private Notice Question

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Alan Ganoo, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 18 June 2013 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues –

Whether, in regard to the case of alleged assault on one Mr Florent Jeannot by the Honourable the Attorney General, on 4 May 2013, he will –

(a) for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Commissioner of Police, information as to if –

- (i) the Honourable the Attorney General has allegedly interfered in the inquiry;**
- (ii) any Cabinet Minister or Chairperson of a statutory body has exerted pressure on Mr F.J. and on his father to withdraw the complaint,**

indicating if same amount to a case of conspiracy to pervert the course of justice; and

(b) state if –

- (i) any action against the Honourable the Attorney General is being envisaged for breach of the Code of Ethics for Barristers; and**
- (ii) in the interest of justice, he proposes to revoke the Honourable the Attorney General forthwith?**
