Private Notice Question

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Béranger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 22 October 2013 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues –

Whether, in regard to the Judiciary, he will state if –

- (a) the President of the Republic has consulted him on the appointment of a new Chief Justice on the office becoming vacant following the retirement of the incumbent, indicating when the said office will become vacant;**
- (b) he has discussed the current appointment of an Acting Chief Justice and Senior Puisne Judge with the President of the Republic or the Chief Justice; and**
- (c) he has recently advised the President of the Republic regarding the approval of requests for Judges of the Supreme Court to undertake any other work?**
