Private Notice Question

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Minister of Local Government and Outer Islands at the sitting to be held today, **Wednesday 13 November 2013 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask the Honourable Minister of Local Government and Outer Islands –

Whether, in regard to the hawkers operating in Port Louis, he will state the –

- (a) date Government decided to resume the control of the ex-CWA and Immigration Square sites in Port Louis identified for the relocation thereof, indicating –
 - (i) the amount of money spent in relation thereto as at to date; and
 - (ii) if the sum of Rs 20 million spent in relation thereto by the Municipal Council of Port Louis will be refunded; and
- (b) details of the commercial projects identified by Government to be implemented on the said sites, indicating how the hawkers will be accommodated thereat?
