To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues –

Whether, in regard to the Boskalis affair, he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain from the –

- (a) Independent Commission Against Corruption, information as to the –**
 - (i) reasons why the Commission has handed over the case to the Police after 4 years;**
 - (ii) names of the persons interviewed in relation thereto;**
- (b) Commissioner of Police, information as to –**
 - (i) if other witnesses have been interviewed;**
 - (ii) if fresh information has been supplied by Boskalis International BV; and**
 - (iii) the names of the persons arrested as at to-date, indicating the charges levelled against them, if any?**
