I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Minister of Information and Communication Technology at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 30 October 2012 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask the Honourable Minister of Information and Communication Technology –

Whether, in regard to the project for the introduction of a new National Identity Card, he will –

- (a) for the benefit of the House, obtain from the State Informatics Ltd., information as to the names of the –**
 - (i) bidders, indicating the value of the respective bids; and**
 - (ii) successful bidder, as approved by the Board thereof in March 2009; and**
- (b) state –**
 - (i) the sums paid to date to Singapore Cooperation Enterprise and Crimsonlogic Pte Ltd. for advisory services;**
 - (ii) how the sum of Rs 1.1 billion was arrived at; and**
 - (iii) if a copy of the Contract Agreement signed on 17 October 2012 will be made public?**
