I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues at the sitting to be held today, **Monday 19 November 2012 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues –

Whether, in regard to the PRB Report 2013, he will state –

- (a) how same was approved by Government when the recommendations thereof widen the gap between the highest and the lowest paid civil servants, indicating the requests submitted by the Unions in relation thereto, including if they have proposed an interim wage increase;**
- (b) the names of the persons proposed by the Unions as Chairperson and Members of the Committee on Errors, Omissions and Anomalies; and**
- (c) if Government has discussed with the Mauritius Employers Federation and the Unions of the private sector regarding any request from the employees of the private sector for an adjustment of their salaries, as a consequence thereof?**
