To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues –

Whether, in regard to the case in which Woman Police Constable N. R. and Mr S. S. were arrested, he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain from the –

- (a) Commissioner of Police, information as to –**
 - (i) if they were released on parole and, if so, the reasons therefor;**
 - (ii) the occupation of Mr S. S.;**
 - (iii) if Mr S. S. has any previous conviction;**
 - (iv) if the detainee whom they met has any previous conviction; and**
- (b) Commissioner of Prisons, information as to –**
 - (i) the content of the memo addressed thereto by the Inspector of the Midlands Police Station;**
 - (ii) if the two Prison Officers facing disciplinary proceedings had precedents?**
