I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 8 May 2012 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues –

Whether, in regard to the Med Point clinic, he will –

- (a) state if five days prior to the 2010 general election, he authorized the tender for the acquisition of a building for the setting up of a geriatric hospital to be issued;**
- (b) for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Independent Commission Against Corruption, information as to the date on which it started an inquiry thereinto, indicating –**
 - (i) if it has referred same to the Director of Public Prosecutions, and**
 - (ii) the date on which it applied for an attachment order and the date same was granted;**
- (c) state the measures taken, if any, for the maintenance of the building and equipment thereof?**
