Private Notice Question

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues at the sitting to be held today, **Thursday 15 November 2012 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues –

Whether, in regard to the alleged attempt by Mr Andrei Kosolapov and Mr Sergei Denisenko to use Mauritius for arms trafficking, he will –

(a) for the benefit of the House –

- (i) obtain from the Commissioner of Police, the Independent Commission Against Corruption, the Bank of Mauritius and the Financial Intelligence Unit information as to if they have completed their inquiries, and, if so, the outcome thereof, indicating if Mr Kosolapov and Mr Denisenko have returned to Mauritius; and**
- (ii) obtain information as to where matters stand concerning the case of forgery entered by Mr Kosolapov against Mr Teddy Harrison; and**

(b) state if Ms Kathi Lynn Austin has now been invited to Mauritius?
