I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 17 July 2012 at 11.30 a.m.**

*To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues –*

**Whether, following the verdict in the Michaela McAreavey Harte murder case, he will state if –**

- (a) a Fact-Finding Commission will be set up;**
- (b) confessions will henceforth be video or audio-recorded;**
- (c) the forensic services will be strengthened;**
- (d) the Jury System will be reviewed;**
- (e) the Police Force will be re-structured; and**
- (f) the Government of Ireland and of Northern Ireland have protested against the publication of crime scene photographs in the Mauritius “Sunday Times” of 15 July 2012 and, if so, the actions, if any, taken/to be taken against the persons involved therein?**
