I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Béranger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Vice-Prime Minister, Minister of Finance and Economic Development, at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 9 November 2010 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask the Honourable Vice-Prime Minister, Minister of Finance and Economic Development –

Whether he is aware that there has been a loss in the purchasing power of the employees of the public and private sectors, old-age pensioners and social aid recipients, since 2005 to-date and if so, will he state if an adequate compensation will be paid as from 01 January 2011, to make up for the loss of purchasing power, indicating if –

- (a) the thresholds for the payment thereof will be raised adequately; and**
- (b) special consideration will be given to the employees, old-age pensioners and social aid recipients of Rodrigues?**
