**Private Notice Question**

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Minister of Health and Quality of Life at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 13 July 2010 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask the Honourable Minister of Health and Quality of Life:-

**Whether, in regard to influenza A (H1N1), she will state –**

- (a) the dates on which the recent cases were detected, indicating (i) if routine surveillance tests were carried out and (ii) the number of cases resulting in death;**
- (b) the type of vigilance which was maintained at the airport, port and hospitals;**
- (c) the stock of vaccines, antiviral drug Tamiflu and masks available, indicating the number of persons vaccinated to-date; and**
- (d) if an information campaign is being launched to sensitize the public on the (i) symptoms and (ii) treatment Protocol?**
