Private Notice Question

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, G.C.S.K., MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Vice- Prime Minister, Minister of Finance and Economic Empowerment, at the sitting to be held today, **Wednesday 27 May 2009 at 11.30 a.m.**

*To ask Dr the Honourable Vice-Prime Minister, Minister of Finance and Economic Empowerment –*

**Whether, in regard to the 5.1 per cent increase in old age pensions, social aid benefits and the salary compensation proposed by Government, he will state –**

- (a) the grades of employees in the public and private sectors who will be excluded by the Rs 12,000 monthly salary ceiling;
- (b) if Government is prepared to raise the 5.1 per cent increase and lift the Rs 12,000 ceiling; and
- (c) if Government will offer another increase as from 01 January 2010?
