I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, G.C.S.K., MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Minister of Education, Culture and Human Resources at the sitting to be held tomorrow, **Thursday 03 December 2009 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask Dr the Honourable Minister of Education, Culture and Human Resources:-

Whether, in regard to the Bachelor of Dental Surgery students of the Sir Seewoosagur Ramgoolam Medical College, he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain information as to if –

- (a) the College is implementing a recommendation of the Tertiary Education Commission for the one year internship to be undergone at the College and, if so, if a sum of USD 3,500 is being claimed therefor from them, without notice or authority;**
- (b) the degrees of the students having completed internship thereat are being withheld until the payment thereof; and**
- (c) a sum of USD 1,750 is being claimed from students for a resit?**
