I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, G.C.S.K., MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence and Home Affairs, at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 16 June 2009 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence and Home Affairs –

Whether, in regard to Rodrigues, he will state –

- (a) where matters stand in respect of the request for the –
 - (i) suspension of fuel tax on air tickets; and**
 - (ii) release of Rs 10m to encourage registered fishermen to shift to other activities;****
- (b) why the Rodrigues Regional Assembly has been sidelined in respect of the Additional Stimulus Package for Rodrigues;**
- (c) if Solit-Air will be allowed to operate; and**
- (d) the number of times he has visited Rodrigues in his capacity as Prime Minister and if he proposes to visit the island in the near future?**
