**Private Notice Question**

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, G.C.S.K., MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence and Home Affairs at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 14 July 2009 at 11.30 a.m.**

*To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence and Home Affairs –*

**Whether, in regard to C. C. he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Commissioner of Police, information as to the circumstances in which he was arrested and left Mauritius, indicating –**

- (a) in both cases if the Interpol has been involved;**
- (b) pending the determination of his appeal –**
  - (i) if the Police had objected to his release on bail; and**
  - (ii) how long after he failed to report to the Bel Ombre Police Station the Police Headquarters was alerted;**
- (c) if anyone has been arrested locally; and**
- (d) if any report has been received from the authorities from France and Réunion Island?**
