I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, G.C.S.K., MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Vice-Prime Minister, Minister of Finance and Economic Empowerment at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 21 July 2009 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask Dr the Honourable Vice-Prime Minister, Minister of Finance and Economic Empowerment –

Whether he has taken cognizance of the judgment of the Supreme Court, dated 19 November 2008, to the effect that the committee, set up under section 11 of the Mauritius Revenue Authority Act for the selection and recruitment exercise of officers, was not lawfully constituted and had acted illegally and, if so, will he, for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Mauritius Revenue Authority, information as to the –

- (a) remedial measures that have been taken; and**
- (b) impact of the judgment, if any, on the Assessment Review Committee in the discharge of its functions and, if so, how?**
