I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, G.C.S.K., MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence and Home Affairs at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 27 October 2009 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence and Home Affairs –

Whether, in regard to the public comments made by the Honourable the Attorney-General, in relation to Police brutality at a Parti Mauricien Social Démocrate meeting on 20 September 2009 and those made by one Yusuf Elahee in the Hebdo on 04 October 2009, in relation to the Honourable the Attorney-General, he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Commissioner of Police, information as to if inquiries have been carried out thereinto and, if so, indicate –

- (a) the number of statements recorded as at to date; and**
- (b) if any arrest has been effected or any radio recordings seized as at to date and, if not, why not?**
