Private Notice Question

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence & Home Affairs, Minister of Civil Service & Administrative Reforms and Minister of Rodrigues & Outer Islands at the sitting to be held today, **Friday 27 June 2008 at 3.30 p.m.**

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence & Home Affairs, Minister of Civil Service & Administrative Reforms and Minister of Rodrigues & Outer Islands:-

Whether, in regard to Zimbabwe, he will state if –

- (a) **Mauritius has made any statement or sent any message in relation thereto, indicating if Mauritius has joined with the other countries of the Southern African Development Community and international organisations and personalities, urging that today's Presidential run-off be postponed and a new date set after talks between the Government and the Opposition of Zimbabwe; and**
- (b) **he has information that President Robert Mugabe has been invited to attend the forthcoming African Union and Southern African Development Community summits, indicating who shall represent Mauritius thereat?**
