Private Notice Question

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence and Home Affairs, at the sitting to be held today, **Friday 19 September 2008 at 3.30 p.m.**

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence and Home Affairs –

Whether, in regard to interim and comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreements between the European Union and the African Caribbean Pacific countries, he will state where matters stand, indicating if –

- (a) Government has scrutinized the comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement initialled by the Caribbean countries in December 2007;**
- (b) he has taken up the matter with the President of the Republic of France, the Prime Minister of the United Kingdom and the President of the European Parliament; and**
- (c) he proposes to attend the forthcoming 6th African Caribbean Pacific Summit in Ghana where the Economic Partnership Agreements issue will top the agenda?**
