Private Notice Question

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence & Home Affairs, Minister of Civil Service & Administrative Reforms and Minister of Rodrigues & Outer Islands at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 08 July 2008 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence & Home Affairs, Minister of Civil Service & Administrative Reforms and Minister of Rodrigues & Outer Islands:-

Whether, in regard to law and order, he will –

- (a) for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Commissioner of Police, information as to if incidents have recently occurred, whereby groups have either taken the law in their hands or displayed firearms and other offensive weapons in public and, if so -**
 - (i) if inquiries have been carried out thereinto and the outcome thereof;**
 - (ii) the new initiatives taken concerning illegal weapons; and**
- (b) state if the Police have been instructed to deal promptly and firmly with such incidents?**
