I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence & Home Affairs, Minister of Civil Service & Administrative Reforms and Minister of Rodrigues & Outer Islands at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 25 March 2008 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence & Home Affairs, Minister of Civil Service & Administrative Reforms and Minister of Rodrigues & Outer Islands:-

Whether, in regard to the electoral reform, he will state -

- (a) when and how he intends to consult political parties thereon;**
- (b) if he has recently received a document thereon prepared by the Honourable Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of Finance and Economic Development and, if so, whether he will circulate same;**
- (c) what he intends to propose in regard to (i) the best loser system (ii) Rodrigues and (iii) women's increased presence in Parliament; and**
- (d) if a draft Bill to amend the Constitution has been prepared?**
