I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Nandcoomar Bodha, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to *the Honourable Minister of Education & Human Resources* at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 24 July 2007 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask the Honourable Minister of Education & Human Resources:-

Whether, in regard to post-secondary education, he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Tertiary Education Commission, information as to –

- (a) the number of applications for registration as post-secondary institutions since July 2005;**
- (b) the number of joint ventures between local institutions and foreign bodies which have been approved since July 2005;**
- (c) the setting up of the Eastern Institute for Integrated Learning in Management (EIILM) University in Mauritius; and**
- (d) if applications are being processed for nursing colleges at (i) the new Apollo Hospital (ii) the Nightingale Nursing College and (iii) the Institute of Technology and Medical Sciences?**
